

CLASSROOM LOCKDOWN KIT

Mission Brief & Intended Use

Critical life-sustainment resources for a standard classroom population during a prolonged lockdown or shelter-in-place event.

1.1 — Mission

To provide critical life-sustainment resources for a standard classroom population (**up to 30 individuals**) during a prolonged lockdown or shelter-in-place event where egress and external support are not possible.

Population

Designed to support up to **30 individuals** within a single confined space.

Scenario

Prolonged lockdown or shelter-in-place where **egress is not possible**.

Assumption

External support is **unavailable or delayed** for the duration of the event.

1.2 — Intended Use

This kit is designed for deployment by **faculty or staff** within an institutional setting after initial lockdown protocols have been executed.

1	Deployment Context Institutional settings such as schools, daycares, and community centers. Activated only <i>after</i> initial lockdown protocols are in place.
2	Sanitation Management Provide hygienic resources to manage waste and maintain a safe confined environment for an extended period.
3	Hydration & Caloric Intake Deliver minimal but sufficient hydration and caloric resources to sustain occupants throughout the event.
4	Minor Medical Support Address minor medical issues that may arise during confinement, reducing the need for external intervention.
5	Situational Awareness Maintain communication and awareness of the incident status until the situation is resolved.



1.3 — Scope & Operational Assumptions

What This Kit Is

- A **short-term sustainment system** for occupants confined to a single room.
- Designed to mitigate the primary challenges of confinement for **up to 24 hours**.
- Operational under the assumption that the **primary threat is external** to the classroom.

What This Kit Is Not

- Not a **tactical response kit** — it does not support active threat engagement or neutralization.
- Not a **heavy rescue kit** — it does not include structural or extrication equipment.
- Not designed for scenarios **exceeding 24 hours** without resupply or evacuation.

  **Operational Assumption:** Occupants are required to shelter in place. The threat environment is external to the classroom, and all protocols are centered on maintaining safety within a secured, single-room environment.
